Lesson outline		<p>We will be introduced to the author and the book and use clues from the front cover and prologue to make some predictions about the story.</p>	<p>We will use the text to retrieve and infer answers to questions about chapter 3 - Whiter than White. We will explore the meaning of words and how to use a range of strategies when we come across unfamiliar words in our reading.</p>	<p>We will explore the main characters in the text in more detail. Our main focus is on Miss Root, the new dentist, and the impression of her that we get as we read about her actions and the way in which the previous dentist died. For some people this will be a sensitive topic. If this applies to you, you may want to do the lesson with an adult. We will look closely at the author's choice of language and characterisation.</p>	<p>We will read the beginning of chapter 13 (Impro!), retrieving and inferring information from the text in order to answer questions. This includes understanding and explaining the order of events, as well as characters' feelings.</p>
