	Lesson outline	<p>In this lesson, we will be exploring the beginning of the religion of Islam. We will learn about the life of the Islamic Prophet Muhammad, who established the religion following revelations from the Angel Gabriel.</p>	<p>In this lesson, we will be studying in detail the five main pillars of Islam; Shahadah, Salat, Zakat, Sawm and Hajj. These are considered by Muslims to be the most important practices of their religion.</p>	<p>Try to build your tennis skills up using different techniques. Start with a book or racket if you have one, use a ball or pair of socks rolled into a ball. Work on keeping the ball in the air. Move into hitting it to a target.
